Digital Cameras & Mobile Phones Policy 2020

PURPOSE

Mobile phones and other digital devices (including digital cameras etc.) are important modern day tools, valuable in providing personal safety and effective communication between students and parents. However, digital technologies can easily be improperly used, lost or damaged and must therefore be effectively managed.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. Students are not to bring personal mobile phones or other digital devices, such as digital cameras, to school unless permission from the principal has been sought by their parents/guardians.
2. The school does not accept responsibility for lost or damaged digital devices.
3. Students' mobile phones must be kept, switched off and in their bags during school hours.
4. Parents who wish to contact students are able to do so via the school office during school hours.
5. Students misusing personal mobile phones or other digital devices, such as digital cameras, at school or causing a nuisance will be brought to the attention of the principal.
6. The principal may revoke a student's permission to bring a mobile phone to school.
7. Students who bring mobile phones or other digital devices, such as digital cameras, to school without prior approval will have their digital device stored at the office until collected by a parent/guardian.
